2023

Only wool and natural fibres accepted. They must be a predominance of protein fibres e.g. sheep, alpaca, goat, rabbit.

Site size and position will be decided by the Woolcraft Committee. We endeavour to do our best with the information that we have, to please everyone.

The Woolcraft Committee ask that demonstrations and products be shared for the betterment of our craft.

The following charge structure has been established.

- Businesses – static \$350
- Businesses – actively demonstrating \$300
- Groups & Individuals – 25% of sales up to a ceiling of \$300
- All monies are paid to Woolcraft Committee so that we can continue to offer this service under the auspices of the A.S.B.A Australian Sheep and Wool Show.

The Woolcraft Committee also asks the demonstrator keep in mind that we are providing the facility and equipment and it would be appreciated if donations of Cash or Kind could be offered as sponsorship to help cover prizes for the Woolcraft Competition and costs incurred.
